WHAT TO BRING EACH DAY

Please ensure your child brings the following each day when attending in vacation care:

- Morning tea, lunch and afternoon tea (ensure all foods are nut-free as children with allergies may be present and please don't bring food that requires heating or cooking
- Sun safe hat
- Plenty to drink (water is available at the Centre at all times)
- · Suitable clothing for the daily activities

Consider bringing the following each day for your child:

- · Additional food if your child gets very hungry
- · An ice-brick in your child's lunch box to keep foods fresh
- · Spending money on excursion days if permitted via the excursion information page
- A change of clothing and underclothing (particularly for younger children who may be prone to accidents)
- Swimmers and towel in the summer months
- · Sunscreen if you prefer your child to use their own

FOODS ON OFFER

Breakfast (low sugar cereal and milk) and afternoon tea (sandwich, fruit or similar) may be provided on parent request. Please let us know if you would like your child to have the option to request these meals. The cost will be \$5 per child per occasion, charged via the fee direct debit system.

The following foods will be on offer as part of the activity or special event planned. Please let staff know if you need further information or have concerns:

Thursday 19 December:

Gingerbread people - flour, butter, sugar, ginger, icing sugar, food colouring, eggs, edible decorations

Friday 20 December and Tuesday 4 January:

Shared Party lunch - please bring a plate of food per child attending with full ingredients list

Monday 6 January:

Roblox fruit salad - Seasonal fruits (such as pineapple, orange, nectarine, grapes, melon)

Tuesday 21 January:

Sausage sizzle lunch - Sausage, bread roll or bread, tomato or bbą sauce, onion, popper juice

Friday 24 January:

Popcorn - microwave popcorn with butter and salt

Tuesday 28 January:

Subway Classics sub platter and wrap platter – assortment of bread/wraps with fillings including ham, turkey, chicken, pepperoni, salami, cheese, tomato, lettuce, avocado, lettuce, tomato, cucumber, capsicum, onion, cheese, Ranch Dressing, mayonnaise, Chipotle Southwest Sauce, Honey Mustard Sauce, Sweet Onion Dressing, and Smoky BBQ Sauce.

Chinese Banquet - Fried rice (GF), honey chicken, vegetarian spring rolls (V), braised chicken with baby corn

FEES AND HOW TO PAY

- All fees are charged via our direct debit system: iDebitPro including excursions and any additional costs.
- All days booked are payable regardless of cancellation once the holiday period has begun. Prior to holiday commencement, we can accept cancellations with notice via email or parent portal message.
- All bookings can be made via the parent portal except same day bookings and bookings for the
 following day if it is after 6pm. Please contact us directly to make last minute bookings or if you need
 assistance.
- Child Care Subsidy (CCS) is available and provides means-tested fees reduction for all eligible families. Register via your MyGov account.
- CCS is not payable for children's first and last days unless they in physical attendance.
- For information on our full fees, please visit our FEES page on our website.
- Children can bring money on excursion days if permitted via the excursion information page. Please advise and guide your child on their purchases beforehand as staff may not be able to see each child's purchase. We recommend no more than \$10 \$15 spending money per child in most cases.

ABOUT EXCURSIONS...

- Most excursions will require all children to participate who are present on the day however sometimes children can choose whether or not to attend an excursion if there will be other children and staff remaining at the Centre. This usually applies to local excursions such as town wander or bushwalk.
- Excursions may be cancelled, postponed or changed due to unforeseen circumstances. If possible, the event will be replaced by another event of similar value. Families will be advised of changes as soon as possible and children will only be taken on excursions with specific authorisation for that event.
- Children who are enrolled to start in kindergarten can attend vacation care from the January school holidays.
- A permission form must be signed by an authorised collector for all children attending excursions.
 Forms are available on our website or we have paper versions at the service.
